TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Payment: An initial deposit of the minimum number of participants for the event is required to confirm the booking time and date, with full payment required a minimum of two weeks in advance. Payment can be made via credit card, cash, cheque or direct deposit on the invoice that will be issued by staff.

Cancellation Policy: All bookings are non-refundable. In the event the activity is cancelled due to weather, an open-ended credit or gift voucher/s will be supplied.

Rescheduling Bookings: Bookings are able to be rescheduled a minimum of 1 week in advance. If within 1 week, a rescheduling fee of \$5 per person will be charged. No reschedules can be made within 48 hours of a booking.

Age Restrictions: Kayaking has a minimum age of 5 years, with all participants 5-7 years of age required to be in a tandem with an adult. All other activities have a minimum age of 8 years.

Indemnity: All participants are required to have an indemnity form filled out prior to participating in an activity. You are able to complete the form on arrival to Walkabout Creek, or in advance online at www.walkaboutcreekadventures.com.au/indemnity.html or with a PDF file (our staff will send you this).

Alcohol Consumption: No alcohol is to be consumed prior to adventure activities. Staff may run breath tests at their discretion.

OUR LOCATION

Walkabout Creek Adventures is located next to the Enoggera Dam at Walkabout Creek, 60 Mt Nebo Road. We are easily spotted by our large green and blue umbrella where our friendly staff will greet you.

Parking: Parking access can be found in two locations as follows:

60 Mt Nebo Road – Park in the three allocated parking areas and follow kayak/Enoggera reservoir signage from the lowest carpark to the water's edge.

The Gap bus stop – park at the bus stop located on Waterworks Rd, walk left 50m up Waterworks Road to enter the area between the two heritage houses. Follow pathway to Enoggera reservoir.

Public Transport: The Gap bus stop is conveniently located right next to an entrance into Walkabout Creek. Take the 385 to the final stop, walk left 50m up Waterworks Road to enter the area between the two heritage houses. Follow pathway to Enoggera reservoir.
